Three definitions of Kronos used in the New Testament:

- 1. The planet earth on which humans have lived (no morality, no understanding)
- 2. The inhabitants inclusive of all peoples (both saved and unsaved)
- 3. The combined activities, affairs, advantages, and accumulated assets of the inhabitants. (inherently bent to evil, worldliness)
