




There is a war going on in our lives. Free will and the law

Romans 4: 13-14

Romans 4:13-15 New International Version (NIV)

13 It was not through the law that Abraham and his offspring received the promise that he would be heir of the world, but through the righteousness that comes by faith. 14 For if those who depend on the law are heirs, faith means nothing and the promise is worthless, 15 because the law brings wrath. And where there is no law there is no transgression.

God promised Abraham a special miracle: Father of many nations. To become the example to all the world.

But this promise was no based on what Abraham could or would do; it was based upon the righteousness of faith.

Not the political correctness of those around us.


It is not the letter of the law but the very spirit of the law

Our first decision criteria is not a criteria at all it is a mindset.

In Matthew 5:20-44, Christ showed that obeying the "letter of the Law" is a matter of physical action, whereas obeying the "spirit of the Law" requires more than just outward actions—it also involves an attitude of the mind—referred to by the Apostle Paul as "circumcision of the heart" (Rom. 2:28-29).

For example, Christ showed that to merely refrain from adultery is obedience to the "letter of the Law," but to obey both the spirit and letter of the Law, one must also exercise self-control ("temperance"—Gal. 5:23), and not even lust after someone (committing "adultery in his heart").

Another example (not mentioned by Christ in Matt. 5) is in the keeping of the Sabbath Day. To merely "remember the Sabbath, to keep it holy" (Ex. 20:8), "not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together" (Heb. 10:25), is in obedience to the letter of the Law. But to also rejoice in the Sabbath and call it a "delight" (Isa. 58:13) is keeping the spirit of the Law, as God intends. This principle applies to all of God's laws.

Decision making is a craft to be mastered. Not an art that will never be perfect





The next six weeks I need you to be conscious of your decisions.


Decide to examine your decisions.

Driving down the street – decision to be courteous, decision to drive with due care, concern for your safety,


Watching the television – is this the best use of my time, DECISION, is what I am watching the best for me

All of these situations, even though they are all based on different hopes or desires, have one thing in common.


They desire God's will to be in line with their own, and they leave enough room in their hopeful prayer to respect


that the Lord is still in control, even if it doesn't go the way they hope.

Each situation shows an expressed belief that God has a plan and a purpose for our lives yet reveals


that they believe we are called to do something along with Him until we get to the point where it's out of our hands.


America extra marital affairs


84% of the population state that they are unacceptable 6% of the population state they is acceptable and normal 10% simply states it doesn't matter.

2.Intellect over emotion


- Emotions rule the immeditate.
