What from this scripture can we learn about eyes?



Charles Spurgeon The motive is the eye of the soul, and if it be clear, the whole character will be right; but if it be polluted, our whole being will become defiled. The eye of the understanding may also be here understood: if a man does not see things in a right light, he may live in sin and yet fancy that he is doing his duty.

1st Century Medical care

- Eyes were the windows to allow light to enter the body and MAKE the body healthy.
- 2. If you had good eyes you were healthy
- 3. Bad eyes you were unhealthy.
 - 1) You were dying
 - 2) The body was falling apart.

- Sincere
- Straight forward
- Without a hidden agenda

Tonight's expanded translation

The illumination of the body is your lens. Therefore if your lens has a single vision, all your body will be full of illumination. But if your lens has double vision or distorted, then all your body will be full of ignorance. Therefore if the illumination that is in you is shadowing all you see, how great is that ignorance to reality !




Matthew 20 – Workers in a vineyard

• Harvest was ripe. Had to get them off the vines

- 1st group 6AM to 6PM twelve hours for a denarii
- 2nd group 9AM to 6PM nine hours for a denarii
- 3rd group Noon to 6PM Six hours for a denarii
- 4th group 5Pm to 6PM One hour for a denarii
- All paid as was promised
- 12 hour workers grumbled
- Verse 15 in most versions is a paraphrase
