

What is wrong with mankind?

Romans 5:8

BUT GOD DEMONSTRATES HIS OWN LOVE FOR US IN THIS; WHILE WE WERE STILL SINNERS, CHRIST DIED FOR US.

SIN

- **Billy Graham:** A sin is any thought or action that falls short of God's will. God is perfect, and anything we do that falls short of His perfection is sin.
- **John Wesley:** A sin is any thought or action that falls short of God's will. God is perfect, and anything we do that falls short of His perfection is sin. Therefore, sin is a willful transgression of a known law.
- **John Calvin:** It is the inherited corruption [from Adam], which the church fathers termed 'original sin,' meaning by the word 'sin' the depravation of a nature previously good and pure."
- **Luther in his Augsburg confession:** writes about sin but does not give a definition
- **Westminster (Presbyterian):** Sin is any want of conformity unto, or transgression of, any law of God, given as a rule to the reasonable creature.
- **I John 3:4,** "Whoever commits sin also commits lawlessness, and sin is lawlessness."

12 Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin,

and so death spread to all men, because * all sinned -

13 for until the Law sin was in the world, but sin is not imputed when there is no law.

14 Nevertheless death reigned from Adam until Moses, even over those who had not sinned in the likeness of the offense of Adam, who is a type of Him who was to come.

Romans 5:12

What conclusions can we make?

12 Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned -

- V12 Sin came into the world
- V12 With this sin came death
- V12 This death spread to ALL men
- V12 The evidence of this spread of death is the exhibited sin in ALL men.

13 To be sure, sin was in the world before the law was given, but sin is not charged against anyone's account where there is no law.

14 Nevertheless, death reigned from the time of Adam to the time of Moses, even over those who did not sin by breaking a command, as did Adam, who is a pattern of the one to come.

1. The sin from verse 12, existed, was understood, was practiced before the LAW as written by Moses 317 laws in the MITZVAT.
2. This PRE-LAW time the lack of conformity to the law which was not written yet was not held against them.

Original Sin – Deep stuff

- Judaism does not see human nature as a permanent impairment by the Sin of Adam
- The very early church did not even speculate on the subject until Paul.
- Augustine the author of the phrase “Original Sin”
- Catholic church acknowledges Original Sin
- Eastern Orthodox does not
- Martin Luther and John Calvin used the word CONCUPISCENCE
- Protestant churches have too views with many interpretations.
 - Many think that Adam’s sin entered into the world, but it does not carry the guilt of it.
 - There are those who believe that Adam’s sin brought only the aspect of physical death to mankind.
 - Others say the Sin of Adam has caused the blight of sin to be a characteristic of all men.
 - Some would restrict this to apply only to those who have reached the age of accountability.
 - Even others say we are born sinners and by nature have a predilection to sin.
