⁸ Owe nothing to anyone except to love one another; for the one who loves his neighbor has fulfilled *the* Law.

⁹ For this, “*YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT ADULTERY, YOU SHALL NOT MURDER, YOU SHALL NOT STEAL, YOU SHALL NOT COVET,*” and if there is any other commandment, it is summed up in this saying: “*LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF.*”

The traveler's attitude: What is mine is mine and I have no need.
The robber's attitude: What is yours if mine if I can steal it
The Levite's attitude: What is yours is too distasteful for me to be bothered
The Priest: attitude: What is mine is mine, But I don't want to get involved.
The Shop Keeper's attitude: What is mine is mine if you can pay for it.
The Samaritan's attitude: What is mine is yours if you need it.
