


Romans 15:22-29


LIVING IN GOLS Plan

Romans 1:13 I do not want you to be unaware, brothers and sisters, that I **planned** many times to come to you (but have been prevented from doing so until now) in order that I might have a harvest among you, just as I have had among the other Gentiles.









Romans 15:22-29 NASB

- 22 For this reason I also have been much hindered from coming to you.
- 23 But now no longer having a place in these parts, and having a great desire these many years to come to you,
- 24 whenever I journey to Spain, I shall come to you. For I hope to see you on my journey, and to be helped on my way there by you, if first I may enjoy your company for a while.
- 25 But now I am going to Jerusalem to minister to the saints.
- 26 For it pleased those from Macedonia and Achaia to make a certain contribution for the poor among the saints who are in Jerusalem.
- 27 It pleased them indeed, and they are their debtors. For if the Gentiles have been partakers of their spiritual things, their duty is also to minister to them in material things.
- 28 Therefore, when I have performed this and have sealed to them this fruit, I shall go by way of you to Spain.
- 29 But I know that when I come to you, I shall come in the fullness of the blessing of the gospel of Christ.

Six Human Needs

- 1. Certainty: assurance you can avoid pain and gain pleasure
- 2. Uncertainty/Variety: the need for the unknown, change, new stimuli.
- 3. Connection/Love: a strong feeling of closeness or union with someone or something.
- 4. Growth: an expansion of capacity, capability or understanding
- 5. Contribution: a sense of service and focus on helping, giving to and supporting others
- 6. Significance: feeling unique, important, special or needed

Of the six basic human needs that drive us that obligates us, is having a sense of significance feeling that we matter, that we're wanted, and appreciated — is critical to our personal growth and well-being.



If you fail to Plan, you plan to fail. If you succeed you will have Significance

Observations from a Project manager

- Planning brings a greater possibility to succeed
- You cannot effectively start without a plan
- Planning has requirements
 - End point what is the result?
 - · Requirements, time, materials, personnel
 - Tasks what do I have to do to get to the end point
 - Dependencies What order are the tasks
 - Timing How much time do I have to complete.

Paul had significance because he had a plan Significance never happens without a plan

What was Paul's plan?

- 1. He had been prevented going to Rome V22
- 2. He was done with this present assignment V23.
- 3. He had a desire go to Rome V23
- 4. He had a desire go to Spain V24
 - 1. On my way stopover V24
 - 2. While in Rome he needed support V24
- 5. Had to go to Jerusalem. V25
 - 1. Macedonia and Achaia had a contribution for Jerusalem V26
 - 2. The contribution was for the poor in Jerusalem V26
 - 3. They were in debt to Jerusalem both spiritual and material V27
 - 4. When that was done continue my journeys V28
- 6. When I get to Rome there will be a blessing V29 (Significance)

Significance never happens without a plan.

Paul's plan was following God's plan for him. It brought him significance

- Paul's plan was to reach the unreached.
- Paul's plan was to honor his commitments.
- Paul's plan was to minister wherever he was.
- Paul's plan was to be content in what ever happened to him.
- Paul's plan was to be a carrier of blessing both spiritual and material.
- Paul's plan was to enjoy fellowship with whomever he worked.
- Paul's plan was always never go alone.
- Paul's plan was always flexible.

What good thing, for the Glory of God, would you like to see happen?

Traps to the lack of Ministry

- 1. I don't know enough You have enough
- 2. My future is not clear enough
- 3. I don't have a clear enough calling
- 4. I am not significant
- 5. I want to my own thing. (priority)

Four major tasks in his plan to go to Rome.

- Romans 15:25-26 Rome was west, I have to go to Jerusalem first
 - Bigger need. Offering of the Gentiles for the Jews in Jeruslaem
 - He had made a commitment to the Gentiles the offering would arrive
- Romans 15:26 Contribution (Koinonia) fellowship
 - The unity of the Christianity depended upon the acceptance of the Jews by the gentiles and gentiles by the jews.
- Romans 15:27 There was a debt to be paid
 - Gentile Christianity came from Jewish roots
 - · Gentile Christianity was in debt. Couldn't spiritually so materially
- Romans 15:28-29 Paul's plan was to do what he had to do before what wanted to do.

Significance

- Significance is being counted on to do what you say you are going to do.
- Significance is being open to detours and excelling anyway.
- Significance is being used by God
- Significance is being committed to God's ministry.
- · Significance is making a plan and doing it.
