Trials, Wisdom, Temptation

- Where does Temptations come from?
 - Starts with trial
 - · We all have them, rich or poor, old or young, we all have trials.
 - We are destined to be men of constant sorrow
 - They are not from God
 - All trials require a response
 - We can give up and cry "Woe is Me"
 - We can persevere resulting is strength from God
 - · We can change a trial into a temptation
 - Take our own path, MY needs, MY wants, MY desires
 - We are enticed dragged, invited to go astray.
 - Temptation's path leads to sin
 - · Sin leads to death.

- The perfect giver is good
- The perfect gift is good and constant
- The perfect gift is good and constant that we may be like HIM in Moral character.
- We become God's possession.



How to not be deceived.

How to overcome sin.

What are the necessary steps to not be deceived?



1. Change our desires

- Desires are the location of the beginning of SIN
- How to change our desires.
 - 1. Change that is inspired buy a large injection of God's word.
 - Psalms 119:11,
 - Matthew 4:3-10
 - 2. Change that is inspired by understanding of God's love
 - · Psalms 116:12-14
 - Psalms 119:104
 - · Changing in our desires takes time. Be patient.

2. Limit our opportunities

- Temptation has two components
 - Desire and opportunity
 - Matthew6:13
 - Matthew 26:41
- Avoiding situations that might excite desire
 - Psalms 101:3-4
 - · Job 31:1
- Avoid those who's behavior encourages sin
 - · Psalms 101:6-7
 - · Colossians 15:33

3. Allow the Holy Spirit to do what He is called to do.

- Fruit of the Spirit includes SELF CONTROL
 - I Corinthians 15:33
 - Galatians 5:22-23
 - · Acts 2:38
 - · Acts 5:32
- The Holy Spirit is an agent of strength
 - Ephesians 3:16
 - Romans 8:12-13
 - Philippians 4:13
 - Ephesians 3:20

4. Overcome failure.

- What if we fail?
- As long as you are alive you still have opportunity.
 - Sin is only victorious in our punishment
 - We can only overcome punishment through forgiveness
 - · I John 2:1-2
 - By his blood we can be forgiven of our present sins
 - · Acts 2:38
 - · Acts 22:16
 - Revelation 1:5
 - · Acts 8:22
 - I John 1:9

We can overcome sin

Stop at any place in the first five sin processes

- 1. Trial
- 2. Temptation
- 3. Entice
- 4. Conception
- 5. Birth
- 6. Death

We can overcome in greater process.
